

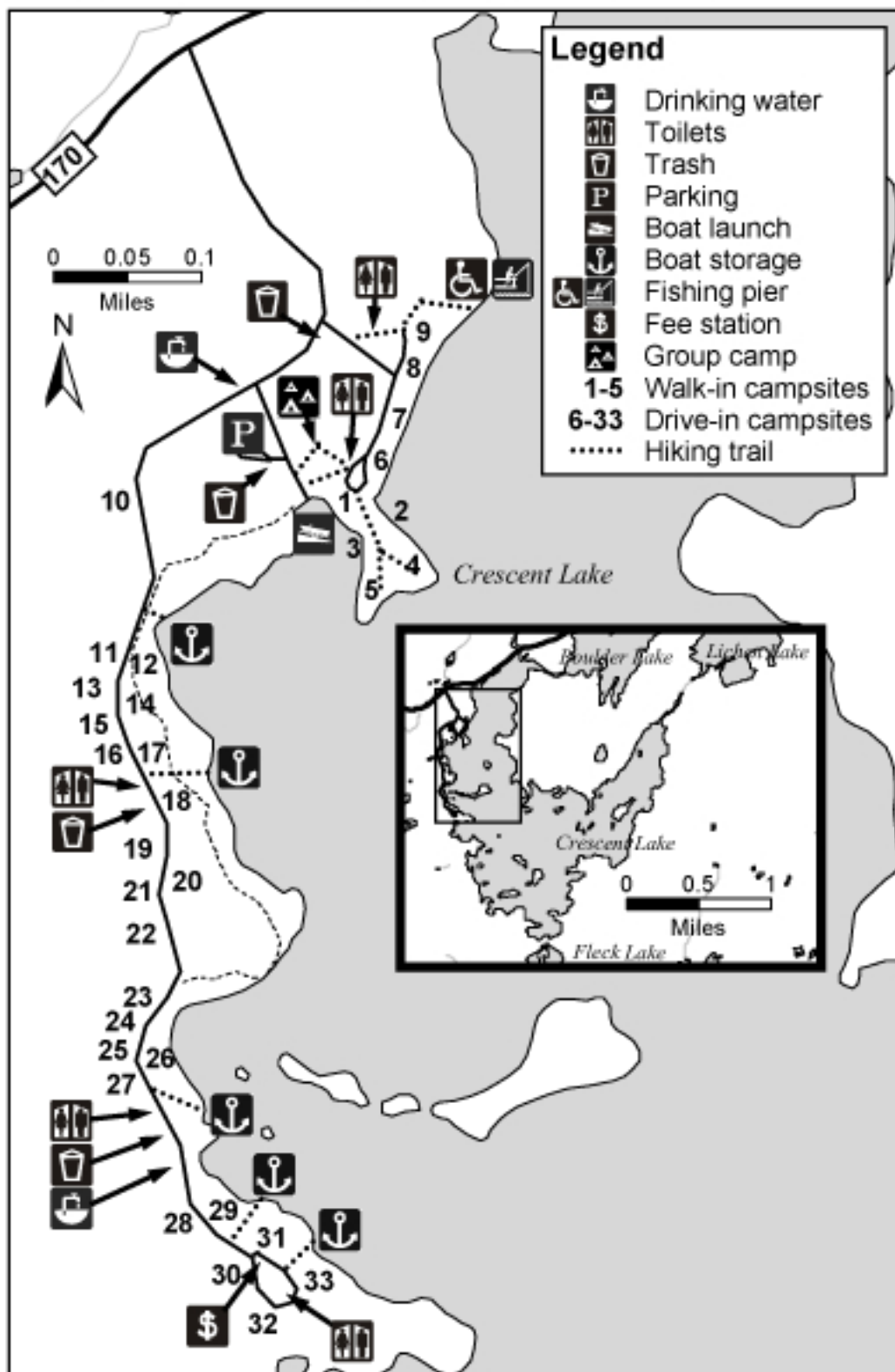
Superior National Forest - Crescent Lake

Description

Crescent Lake Campground offers a variety of family camping experiences, including drive-in RV or tent sites, walk-in tent sites, group site, and a site accessible to those with mobility impairments. Drinking water is available from solar powered wells, sanitary facilities are vault toilets. There are no trailer dump stations or electrical hook-ups.

Fishing Crescent Lake for walleye, muskie, and northern is easy with a boat ramp and trailer storage area, a barrier-free fishing pier, and several boat storage areas for canoes. From Crescent Lake, it is possible to portage into several other lakes (see inset map and Crescent Lake Canoe Route flyer).

A quarter mile trail gives a short hiking opportunity through a forest thick with conifers and birch trees.
